Catastrophic injuries happen all too often, shattering lives and leaving victims searching for help and the financial resources to move forward. In 2009, in what he describes as the hardest-fought case of his career, Tommy Malone obtained a \$49 million verdict on behalf of a young man who suffered a traumatic brain injury caused by two inattentive truck drivers on a dangerous roadway in San Jose, Calif.

Other landmark verdicts include \$7.8 million in the wrongful death of a 31-year-old woman crushed between two tractor-trailers while working as a security guard at a Kmart distribution center, and \$5.5 million in compensatory damages for brain damage suffered by a 49-year-old man after a truck driver crossed the center of a divided highway and collided with the plaintiff's car.

The firm carefully evaluates each case to ensure only meritorious cases are brought to court and strictly limits the number of cases it accepts to ensure each client receives the highest level of attention. "Though most of our cases settle, we prepare every case with the intention of trying it before a jury," says Adam Malone.

The two attorneys also represent many clients whose injuries are the result of medical negligence, including brain injuries suffered at birth. In 2009, Adam Malone obtained \$24.5 million in compensatory damages for the unnecessary and preventable amputation of a Georgia teen's right leg.

"One of the greatest rewards I have is the knowledge that Adam is going forward with the same level of devotion to our clients," says Tommy Malone. "I am blessed to be able to practice law with him."
